



Sunshine Coast 1-Day Tour

Stunning Aussie Beaches, Headland Walks & Seaside Towns

After being picked up from your Brisbane hotel, your knowledgeable guide will give you the region's convict history, European settlement and Aboriginal history. As you pass the uniquely shaped Glass House Mountains, learn how these fascinating volcanic plugs were formed. We then head to Australia's most fashionable beach town, Noosa.

Look out for koalas on a guided eco-walk around the headland of Noosa Heads National Park, with stunning views of secluded bays, beaches and out to the ocean. Stop for a dip in the ocean or at the many look-out points to view the passing marine-life such as manta rays, turtles and dolphins.

Visit Noosa's famous Hastings Street for 'ultra-luxe' shopping and trendy cafes or simply relax on one of the world's most beautiful beaches.

The drive from Noosa to Coolool along the coastal road provides gorgeous ocean views. We pass the uniquely dome-shaped 200-metre (600 foot) high Mt Coolool. A steep yet rewarding climb of the mountain is on offer for those interested in the spectacular 360-degree views of the coast and hinterland.

Stroll along the popular beach at Mooloolabah and if the tide is right, walk out to a beautiful sandbar with views of the Maroochy River, past Pincushion Island to the Pacific Ocean. Enjoy lunch with lovely views across to Mooloolabah Beach at a restaurant with great local cuisine.

From King's Beach, one of the coast's most popular beaches, enjoy the beautiful walkway around Caloundra's headland to Happy Valley and Bulcock Beach. Stop for a leisurely afternoon tea virtually over the water at a cafe with gorgeous views across the sandbars of the Pumicestone Passage to Bribie Island.
