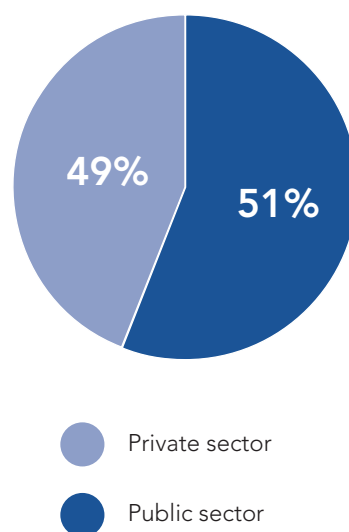
1. To provide a unique opportunity for city and business leaders within the region to reconnect, discuss common challenges and identify solutions.

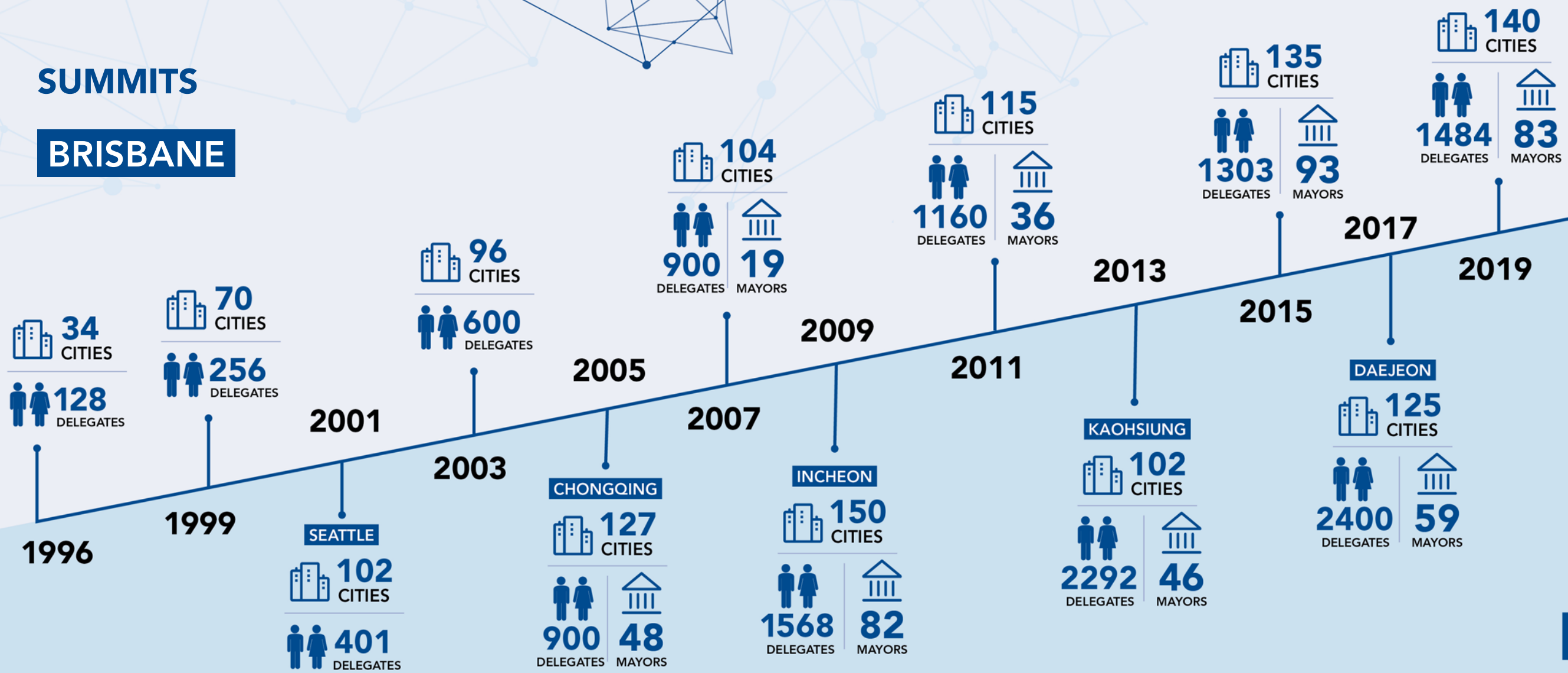
